**VICTIM BAIL NOTIFICATION PROTOCOL  
HASTINGS COUNTY**

The Parties to this agreement acknowledge that it is of the utmost importance that victims of serious violence be notified as soon as possible of the terms of an accused person's release from custody after being charged. Serious violence includes, but is not limited to domestic violence, child abuse and sexual assault.

**Initial Release**

The investigating police service is responsible for notifying victims that the accused has been released or detained. The victim should be advised of any terms or conditions of release.

**Variation of Release Conditions**


Release conditions will be varied on consent at 15 Victoria Avenue, at the time of the bail hearings scheduled for that particular day. Conditions affecting young offenders may be varied on consent, or after a hearing, at Young Offender Court. The investigating police service is responsible for notifying victims of these variations.


**Bail Review**

The Crown Attorney's office is responsible for notifying victims of any orders made affecting the detention of the accused and/or variations made to release conditions by the Superior Court.
