

SEXUAL ASSAULT PROTOCOL TRAINING

Protocol Training is integral to making the Protocol an active working community document. Each of the Signatory Partner Agencies commit to organizing, providing and/or participating in in-house training and professional development opportunities for employees in relation to sexual assault. They also commit to organizing, providing and/or participating in inter-agency, community-based training and professional development opportunities relating to sexual assault.

The Protocol Committee of the QCCAV will ensure that interagency protocol training occurs. Each Signatory Partner Agency will designate a staff representative to be an agency training lead to the Protocol Committee. The agency training lead will be the contact person for Protocol Committee to share and receive information regarding internal and interagency partner abuse training initiatives.

The Protocol Committee will be responsible for:

- Receiving annually from each Signatory Partner Agency their internal protocol training plan;
- Developing an interagency training team to provide annual on site Protocol Training to Signatory Partner Agency staff and associate agencies that request training.
- Ensuring that the content of protocol training remains accurate and that multiple mediums are used in the training.
- Organizing, coordinating and evaluating the Protocol training sessions.
- Establishing a link with the QCCAV Education and Training sub-committee regarding annual community partner abuse training events.
- Reporting on training at each meeting of the Protocol Committee.
